5. Drop off/pick up & Parking on School Property:

<u>Please respect the no vehicle rule in our emergency vehicle loop</u>. We provide orange pylons as a visual reminder to not enter but have space for a vehicle to go through to access the accessible parking spots (accessible parking pass must be visible).

Parking on school property:

This is a reminder that Pre-Primary families need to have a purple parking pass to access the driveway close to the school entrance. There is short term parking designated for pre-primary families in 8 parking spaces by the modular fencing. There is also short term parking along the sidewalk by the playground. Please ensure your parking pass is visible on your dash when you park. Vehicles without a visible parking pass will be asked to move their vehicle and/or may receive a parking ticket.

Our campus is fortunate to be able to offer approximately 50 parking spots to visitors. The spots are on the perimeter of the <u>lower parking lot in front of the field</u> (around the edges of the parking lot). The parking spots in the middle of that parking lot are for the WBS and WBH staff parking. When dropping your children off, you can use the drop and go loop OR park in one of the perimeter parking spots and walk your child to the school. There is NO parking out back for

Pre-Primary to Grade 6 families and NO parking in the upper parking lot for Primary to Grade 6 families. Please respect these procedures so that staff have places to park, and we can keep students safe.
