- All SAC Discussion overcrowding/Decision on letter to HRCE before decision/plan made:
- SAC Co-Chair is recommending letter proactively be sent to HRCE to ensure SAC input is taken into account before HRCE decisions/plans made? No consultation has occurred since 2023 or none been announced by the Executive Director or Minister.
 - Members of Parent/Community page canvassing interest to start a petition on overcrowding and revisit boundaries.
 - Some parents citing that their students are struggling with the overcrowding / impacts on student life (recess/lunch times, class sizes, gym and outdoor space use, limited extra-curricular activities, crowded indoors and out). Notably, some cite vacant classrooms at others schools and wanting to transfer their children to smaller schools next year. Some are fine with the size and had similar concerns at their former schools.
 - Possible Actions for SAC discussion/decision:
 - Include questions on these issues in student and family/community surveys to capture balanced and objective feedback
 - Send letter to HRCE to ensure SAC/student family/community input is taken into account BEFORE decisions/plans are made
 - Invite parents/community to SAC meeting for discussion
