Hello Families,

- 1. <u>Update on our School Parking Lot Safety Procedures & Recommendations</u>
  We will be installing a "No left turn-Right hand turns only" sign when exiting the visitor parking lot. Having vehicles turning right keeps the traffic within the parking lot flowing and limits the congestion. <u>We encourage all cars to turn right when exiting</u>, even though the signage is not yet installed.
