- <u>2024 Student Success Survey Grade 4-8 Students</u>: The Department of Education and Early Childhood Development has once again engaged Narrative Research to conduct the online Student Success Survey with all students in grades 4-12 (like previous school years). The 2024 Student Success Survey will be available for schools to view and administer between April 22<sup>nd</sup> and May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

### Key Points:

- The survey will be conducted in all public schools with all students in grades 4-12.
- The online survey is available from April 22 to May 10, 2024.
- The survey will be accessed in English at <u>studentsuccessns.ca</u>.
- Schools should allow 40 minutes for the survey (50 minutes at the elementary level). A short break can be given as needed by leaving the survey window open.
- The survey is only available for completion at the school, as it is connected to the school's IP address.
- The survey will provide valuable information to the school regarding students' experiences at school.
- School reports will be returned in June.
  The Student Success Survey results provide schools with important information regarding student experiences that help shape supports to student well- being and to inform student success plans.

Although we want and encourage all students to participate in the survey, there may be some parents/guardians who do not wish for their children to participate. As well, we want and encourage all students to answer all survey questions, however they may skip over any questions that they are not

comfortable answering. A Parent/Guardian notice was sent home on Thursday, April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2024 to families who have a child in Grades 4 to 8.
