There are school requirements that we must follow to get ready for the third term report cards and the 2024-2025 school year.
- 2. <u>Home and School Information</u>: As we think ahead to next year, we are looking for volunteers to be a part of our Home and School Association. We have openings for executive positions and general members. There will be a google form going out to all families where you can express your interest in being a part of this committee.

There are two ongoing fundraisers that support our Home & School Association year round.

- **4.** <u>Yearbooks:</u> We have received word that our 2023-2024 yearbooks will be arriving next week. We will communicate a plan for distribution to students and families once they have arrived.
- 5. <u>Cafeteria Services:</u> The final day for cafeteria services for students in grades PP to 8 will be on Wednesday, June 26^{th,} 2024.
- **6.** <u>2024-2025 Grade level Supply Lists:</u> The supply lists for next year will be posted on our school's website in early July. Please note that we have tried to create supply lists that are mindful of cost for families.
- 7. Information about the 2024-2025: Information about the next school year will start to be sent to families in August. Please check your email or the school's website for information around our September opening, such as the first few days of school: morning drop off and afternoon pick up, parking lot procedures, the new lunch program, and class lists.
- **8.** <u>Class Lists:</u> Our teachers work very hard to create classes that allow students to thrive and learn. We recognize that families may have placement requests for their children. Please understand that we value your input, but we are not able to fulfill requests at this time.

- 9. School Modulars: The construction for our school modulars has begun. This has had an impact on our parking location for staff of the PP-8 school. Staff members are now parking in the lower parking lot. There is still room for families to park and walk their child(ren) to the doors of the school, but we wanted to provide information around why the parking lot is fuller these days. - 12. West Bedford High Orientation Night for Families of Gr. 7 & 8 students next year:

 Families of students heading into Grade 7 & 8 next year are invited to a parent session with the High School Admin team. This session will take place on Wednesday, June 25th at 6:30 to 7:30pm. This is for parents only. The High School will do some tours with students on June 21st during the school day to introduce them to the school. The High School Admin team are looking forward to seeing you all on the 25th.

Dismissal for students will be 4 hours earlier than the regular schedule. For West Bedford School, this means that our dismissal time will be 10:15 am, with the latest bus departure at 10:35 am.
